Application Steps:

Apply through the Global Mobility Database

Receive Approval - if places available/program going ahead

Pay Deposit

Receive Departmental Permission – from the School of Languages and Cultures (SLC) Administration Office

Enrol in Sydney Student – before last day to add a Unit of Study for Intensive June (S1CIJN); Intensive November (S2CINO); Intensive December (S2CIDE) **Remember:** Your request for Enrolment will not be approved without Departmental Permission.

Note: If you receive two "Approvals", pay two deposits, you will not receive a Refund, but you will need to decide which location to travel to.
