



Status	Meaning
Pending	Students have not completed/Submitted their Application in the Global Mobility Database and cannot be Approved; Waitlisted; or, Unsuccessful.
Submitted	Students have completed/Submitted their Application in the Global Mobility Database and can now be Approved; Waitlisted; or, Unsuccessful.
Approved	Students have been Approved to pay their Fee and Commit in the Global Mobility Database.
Waitlisted	Students have been added to the Waitlist as the number of Applicants exceeds the Maximum Number of Students the Host/Partner Institute can accommodate. Waitlisted Students may be Approved if previously Approved Students do not pay their Fee and Commit in the Global Mobility Database by the due date.
Withdrawn: Program Full	Students have completed/Submitted their Application in the Global Mobility Database but as the number of Applicants exceeds the Maximum Number of Students the Host/Partner Institute can accommodate, they are Unsuccessful based on the first-come-first-served Approval Process.
Committed	Students have been Approved and paid their Fee and Committed in the Global Mobility Database. Committed Students will be emailed a Letter of Acceptance/Departmental Permission Letter from the School of Languages and Cultures before enrolling through Sydney Student (Enrolments without the Letter of Acceptance/Departmental Permission Letter from the School of Languages and Cultures will be automatically declined by Sydney Student)
Withdrawn: pre-decision	Students have Withdrawn before Submitting; after being Approved/Waitlisted; or, before Committing to their Application.
Withdrawn (did not submit application): by staff	Pending Applications are Withdrawn by Staff as Applicants did not Submit Applications.
Withdrawn: didn't commit	Submitted Applications are Withdrawn by Staff as Applicants didn't Commit to their Applications.
Withdrawn: by staff	Committed Applications are Withdrawn by Staff as Committed Applicants cannot Withdrawn themselves after Committing to their Applications.
